

Who Is Eligible?

To be considered eligible for Marin Access Paratransit a rider must be:

- Unable to independently board, ride, or exit an accessible Golden Gate Transit or Marin Transit fixed route bus, or similar transit vehicle because of your disability
- OR
- Unable to travel to or from a transit stop because of your disability

What is Paratransit ?

Paratransit is transportation for individuals who cannot ride the public bus due to a disability.



What Will It Cost?

Rides within Marin are \$2 (\$2.50 if outside the service area). For rides beginning or ending outside of Marin the fare is based on fare zones.

Low income riders can receive free tickets for local rides through our low income ride program.

Where Can I Ride?

Marin Access Paratransit riders can use the service to travel within Marin County as well as to travel to parts of San Francisco, Contra Costa and Sonoma Counties.

The service operates within 3/4 of a mile of an active public transit route. Those outside the service area will be served on an as-available basis.

When Can I Ride?

Marin Access Paratransit operates seven (7) days a week during the same hours as public transportation

How Does It Work ?

Once determined eligible riders must call one (1) to seven (7) days in advance to schedule their rides.

Riders are given 30 minute pickup windows for their trips.



Paratransit is a ride share program. Because of this a riders' times may be changed up to an hour to accommodate other riders
