

## What is Marin Transit?

Marin County Transit District (Marin Transit) was established by a vote of the people in Marin County in 1964 and was given the responsibility for providing local transportation services within Marin County.

In an effort to better serve Marin County adults and people with disabilities in Marin, Marin Transit formed Access in 2010 to focus on the improvement of transportation for this population. In doing so Marin Transit has been able to implement and support the programs contained in this brochure.

## Catch-A-Ride

- Marin residents who are ADA eligible., age 80+ or age 60+ and no longer driving
- \$14 subsidy toward rides (\$18 if low income)
- 8 one-way rides a month
